The Chief Engineer(Waste Water Management) invites tenders from eligible tenderers for the **Work of Construction of 15 MLD ISPS at KSRTC Printer Press Road, Shantinagar.(3rd call)** Tenderers are requested to submit their tender, EMD and details of their capability to undertake the tender (as detailed in ITT Clause-3 & 6) in the Karnataka e-Procurement Portal. Price tender will be opened only if the Tenderer is found to be qualified to execute the tendered works. Tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in clause 3 of the Instructions to Tenderers to qualify for award of the contract.

1. Tender documents may be downloaded through e-Procurement Portal www.eproc.karnataka.gov.in website only from Interested Tenderers may obtain further information by accessing the same website.
2. Tenders must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit specified for the work in the Table below. EMD will have to be in any one of the forms as specified in the Tender document and shall have to be valid for 45days beyond the validity of the tender.
3. The last date and time for receipt of tenders in the Electronic Tender Box in website (www.eproc.karnataka.gov.in) is 26-05-2022 up to 17:30 hrs. SECTION 2:

INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS (ITT)

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A. General

1. Scope of Tender

1.1 The **Chief Engineer (WWM)**, (Referred to as Employer in these documents) invites tenders following Two Stage e-Procurement Portal procedure, from eligible Tenderers, Work of Construction of 15 MLD ISPS at KSRTC Printer Press Road, Shantinagar. (as defined in these documents and referred to as "the work") detailed in the Table given in the Invitation for Tenders (IFT).

2. Eligible Tenderers

2.1 Tenderers shall not be under a declaration of ineligibility for corrupt and fraudulent practices issued by the Government of Karnataka

2.2 Tenders from Joint ventures are not acceptable.

3. Qualification of the Tenderer:

3.1 All Tenderers shall provide the requested information accurately and in sufficient detail in Section 3: Qualification information.

3.2 To qualify for award of this contract, each Tenderer in its name should have in the last five years i.e. (2017-18 & 2021-22)

a) Achieved in at least two financial years a minimum financial turnover (in all classes of civil engineering construction works only) of **Rs.792.80 lakh**.

b) As a Prime Contractor, the tenderer should have satisfactorily completed at least one similar work such as **Work of Construction and Commissioning of Intermediate sewage pumping station(ISPS)/TSPS of value not less than Rs 198.20 lakhs**

c) The tenderer should have executed in any one financial year, a minimum experience in Design, Construction and Commissioning of **12 MLD** ISPS /TSPS work in any Government Agency.

3.3 Each Tenderer should further demonstrate:

b. Liquid assets and /or availability of credit facilities of not less than ~~Rs. Rs.99.10 lakh~~ (Credit lines/letter of credit/certificates from Nationalised / Schedule banks in India for meeting the fund requirement etc.,

3.4 To qualify for a package of contracts made up of this and other contracts for which tenders are invited in this IFT, the tenderer must demonstrate having experience and resources to meet the aggregate of the qualifying criteria for the individual contracts.

3.5 Sub-contractors experience and resources shall not be taken into account in determining the Tenderers compliance with the qualifying criteria except to the extent stated in 3.2 above.

3.6 Tenderers who meet the above specified minimum qualifying criteria, will only be qualified, if their available tender capacity is more than the total tender value. The available tender capacity will be calculated as under:

$$\text{a) Assessed available tender capacity} = (A * N * 1.5 - B) \geq \text{Rs. 396.40 lakhs}$$

where

A = Maximum value of civil engineering works executed in any one year during the last five years (updated to 2021-22 price level at 10% per year) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of the works for which tenders are invited.

B = Value, at 2021-22 price level, of existing commitments and on-going works to be completed during the next **12 months**.

Note: The statements showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be countersigned by the Employer in charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent.

disqualified if they have:

- made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
- record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history, or financial failures etc.; and/or
- participated in the previous Tender for the same work and had quoted unreasonably high tender prices and could not furnish rational justification.

4. One Tender per Tenderer:

4.1 Each tenderer shall submit only one tender for one package. A tenderer who submits or participates in more than one tender (other than as a sub-contractor or in cases of alternatives that have been permitted or requested) will cause all the proposals with the Tenderer's participation to be disqualified.
