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# Invitation for Expressions of Interest for Collaboration on Urban Water Management Projects under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Initiatives

**Introduction:** Bangalore Water Supply and Sewerage Board (BWSSB), one of the first water supply and sanitation utility in India was established in the year 1964 to provide water supply and safely manage sanitation. BWSSB is an autonomous body formed by the State legislature under Bangalore Water supply and Sewerage Act. BWSSB's jurisdiction covers an area of 800 sq.km and includes Bengaluru core area (245 sq.km), 8 urban local bodies (330 sq.km) and 110 villages (225 sq.km) and serves 13.193 million people.

Rapid urbanization and industrialization of Bangalore has created tremendous pressures on available resources, which multiplied with mushrooming of various IT industries, prompting Bangalore to expand both horizontally and vertically. Presently the water supply need of Bangalore is being satisfied through the surface water augmented from river Cauvery, supplying 1450 MLD of water. Further, to augment additional 775 MLD of water, Cauvery V stage project funded by JICA is under progress and proposed to be commissioned by May 2024. Apart from this, around 400 MLD of underground water is also being extracted.

However, due to climate change there is some reduction in rainfall, as such the ground water is depleted, resulting in water crisis, especially in the peripheral area of the Bangalore. This is an alarm to Bangaloreans drawing attention towards development of Bio-retention system and adoption of Rain Water Harvesting system (RWH).

The adoption and financing for Bio-retention system, BWSSB invite the EOI from the agencies having adequate and relevant experience in the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Sector. The interested agencies may submit their EOI along with technical proposal on or before 2.4.2024 at 16.00Hrs through KPP Portal.

- The leveraging CSR engaged in social transformation through implementing agency or directly registered with Ministry of Corporate Affairs which are having at least 05 years of experience of working preferably with State Governments/Government of India, agencies such as UN/bilateral/multi-lateral funding/ partner agencies and corporates including CPSEs in social development sector with valid registration/recognition from state/central Govt. of India.

- The Agency should have experience in conducting impact assessment of projects implemented in the thrust areas of Bio-retention Development, natural filtration for SWD's, Green Infrastructure for water & sewage treatment and RWH
